In honor of the Maurer Meals Mission, UMF dining services will offer a “scholarship” of 50 meals to be used at the dining commons during the Spring 2014 semester. 2. Submit a **well, written** essay of 500 to 1000 words demonstrating:

 - b. Community involvement in promoting sustainability, local agriculture, nutrition or other area relevant to the Maurer Meals mission.
 - c. Briefly, how this scholarship will financially impact your experience at UMF.
